This Engagement Letter for legal services (the “Letter”), effective as of the date above, confirms your engagement of BW Law PLLC d/b/a WINIT LAW (“Winit Law”) to represent you in/for the above-referenced summons/ticket. In furtherance of your engagement of Winit Law, it is jointly agreed that:

- **Case; Retainer Payment:** Winit Law will represent you in the applicable court in connection with the above-referenced summons/ticket. It is confirmed that you have paid Winit Law the applicable fee(s) for the above-referenced summons/ticket, which fee(s) covers our legal services under this Letter in respect of the above-referenced summons/ticket (and no other) until the case is completed. The fee will be placed in Winit Law’s operating account and is subject to refund only if Winit Law does not complete the assignment or you choose to terminate our representation before the assignment is completed.
- **Future Summons/Tickets.** For any other summons/ticket that is issued to you for which you seek our professional services and representation, this Letter will cover all such representations once you’ve paid the applicable fees for that other summons/ticket, and we’ve confirmed such representation. Until (1) you have confirmed our engagement on each such other summons/ ticket and paid the corresponding fee therefore and (2) Winit Law has confirmed such representation, you will not be represented by Winit Law on any other summons/ticket besides the one referenced above.
- **Fines:** Fines, penalties, traffic school costs, court costs and any other expenses of any kind that may be assessed against you for or in connection with the above-referenced summons/ticket shall be your sole responsibility. In addition, any expenses incurred or advanced by Winit Law in connection with providing legal services may be billed separately and will be reimbursable by you.
- **Assignment / Delegation:** You acknowledge and agree that Winit Law may, at its own cost and at no additional cost to you, retain or contract with attorneys outside of Winit Law to assist and participate as co - counsel in your representation, whether in New York or in other jurisdictions. Although a portion of the fee you pay to Winit Law may be allocated to such co - counsel based on the proportion of work performed by each firm,

Winit Law will remain responsible for your representation in the summons / ticket along with co - counsel, as applicable. Winit Law, not you, will be solely responsible for any co - counsel's fees and expenses. If co - counsel is retained, the fee split between Winit Law, and co - counsel will be disclosed in this agreement.

Winit Law and Co-counsel will divide the Fee, with Co-counsel receiving \$undefined and Winit Law receiving \$NaN, but this won't increase the total Fee in any way. By signing this Agreement, you provide your consent to this division of the Fee. ## **WINIT LAW ENGAGEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **Disputes.**

If any dispute arises under the letter, Winit Law and the party named therein (the “client”) shall undertake to negotiate in good faith to settle such dispute as soon as practicable on mutually acceptable terms. If the parties cannot resolve such dispute themselves within 30 days, then either party may submit the dispute to mediation by a mediator approved by both parties. If the parties cannot reach agreement in a mediation or if either party does not wish to abide by any decision of the mediator, then either party shall submit the dispute to in-person arbitration before a single arbitrator in the State of New York, County of New York, pursuant to the Streamlined Procedures of the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association (AAA) then in effect (the “AAA Rules”). The parties may agree upon an arbitrator; if they are unable to do so within ten (10) business days of the filing of a Statement of Claim, they shall follow the arbitration selection procedures set forth in the AAA Rules. Each party shall bear its own costs and expenses of the arbitration, including attorney’s fees, except that, the arbitrator may impose costs and reasonable attorneys’ fees as a sanction for conduct that violates the AAA Rules, including without limitation the discovery provisions thereof.

If Client disputes any fee between \$1000 and \$50,000, Client may avail themselves of the arbitration procedures of the New York Dispute Resolution Program pursuant to 22 NYCRR Sect. 137.00; Winit Law will provide Client with the Rules for that Program upon request.

### **Choice of Law:**

All of the rights and obligations of Winit Law and Client arising under or related to the Letter shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York, irrespective of any conflict of law rules or the laws of the state of Client’s residence.

### **Scope of Engagement.**

Winit Law's representation is and shall be limited to the scope of engagement provided in the cover letter appended hereto. Any changes thereto shall require the prior consent of both Client and Winit Law.

### **Payment Failure.**

In the event that Winit Law is unable to process a payment or if a payment is canceled, Winit Law shall charge Client a Ten Dollar (\$10.00) service fee per each failed payment attempt, all in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. To the extent permitted by applicable law, any delinquent or late payments shall also incur interest at a rate of one and a half (1.5%) per month as of due date, or the maximum lesser amount permitted by applicable law. Client will also be solely liable for any related “insufficient fund” charges or other penalties which may be imposed by his/her bank. If Winit Law is unable to process a payment, Winit Law’s representation hereunder and its associated services may immediately be suspended or cease (if permitted in such state). In addition to the amount(s) due Winit Law, delinquent accounts and/or chargebacks will be charged with fees and/or charges that are incidental to the collection of delinquent accounts and/or chargebacks, including without limitation, collection fees and/or other third-party charges. Client hereby expressly agrees that all communications in relation to delinquent accounts may be made by Winit Law or by any third party on its behalf, including without limitation, a third-party collection agent. If that happens, Client will be responsible for paying all collection fees assessed by the third-party collection agency. The remedies stipulated in this

Section shall not derogate from any other right or remedy available to Winit Law by law or under these Terms. Client agrees not to initiate any chargebacks with their credit card issuer for any fees paid to the Firm under this agreement. Any disputes regarding fees will be addressed directly between the Client and the Firm and resolved in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

**Delivery of Client Records.**

Upon conclusion of the engagement contemplated under the Letter or upon Client's written request, Winit Law shall deliver all records and notes that are in Winit Law's possession or under its control and that are Client's property or relate to Client's legal matter. Winit Law shall have the right to retain a copy of these records and notes for its files, at Winit Law's sole expense; this copy shall be kept confidential.

**No Warranty.**

Winit Law makes no guarantees as to the outcome or results to be achieved in connection with its representation of any matter.

**Installment Payment Program.**

Winit Law may offer its installment payment program (the "Payment Program") to eligible clients in certain markets and for specific categories of traffic tickets. If Client's ticket qualifies for the Payment Program, Client will be prompted to enroll therein at the time of any form of checkout on Winit Law's website. Winit Law reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify its eligibility and qualification requirements from time to time. Notwithstanding Client's desire to participate in the Payment Program, Winit Law reserves the right to withhold or refuse Client's participation for any reason or to impose any additional requirements deemed necessary by Winit Law in its sole discretion, subject to applicable laws and regulations. Any participation in the Payment Program is entirely voluntary and the failure of Client to participate will not disqualify Client from retaining Winit Law. Winit Law reserves the right to utilize the services of a third party to manage all or any aspect of the Payment Program, and therefore, Client expressly consents to allow Winit Law to share Client's enrollment, registration, payment and ticket information with such third party, and Client may be required to register with such third party for purposes of participating in the Payment Program. Client's participation in the Payment Program will require a down payment equal to an amount expressly approved by Winit Law plus any applicable vendor processing fees, and the balance (together with any other fees and surcharges imposed by Winit Law) to be paid in the form of monthly installment payments over such period mutually approved by Winit Law and Client, until such time as Client's fees are paid in full (i.e., failure to remit the down payment will immediately void Client's enrollment/participation in the Payment Program). Besides adding a service provider processing charge to Client's fees, Winit Law may also charge a finance fee and a default fee, both of which will be disclosed to Client at the time of Client's enrollment in the Payment Program. Winit Law reserves the right to terminate Client's participation in the Payment Program if Client fails to remit any monthly installment payment in a timely manner, whereupon Client will be required to remit all of the remaining fees which are due and owing in full within twenty-four (24) hours from Winit Law's email notice of default. Subject to applicable laws and regulations, Winit Law reserves the right to immediately terminate Client's representation and cease rendering its services upon any such default. No modifications to the terms of Client's Payment Program participation shall be binding unless expressly approved in advance and via email by a Winit Law authorized representative.

**Independent Contractor Status.**

Winit Law is an independent contractor insofar as Client is concerned. In such capacity as an independent contractor, Client acknowledges and agrees that: (a) Winit Law (and any co-counsel, as applicable) has the right to perform legal services for others during the term of the Letter; (b) Winit Law has the sole right to control and direct the means, manner and method by which the legal services required under the Letter will be performed; and (c) Winit Law has the right to utilize the services of associates, paralegals and other support personnel to assist it in carrying out the legal services under the Letter, and to delegate legal services to other attorneys in the role of co-counsel.

**Data Sharing.**

Winit Law may share information and data regarding Client's representation with co-counsel and third-party service providers that render services comprised of quality assurance, data analytics, customer support and general marketing; provided that, such data will not violate any privilege or other confidentiality obligations that Winit Law owes to its clients.

**Contact.**

Winit Law may contact Client via any means agreed to with Client, including without limitation, telephone, mail, SMS, and email in connection with any and all cases then-being handled by Winit Law and/or to notify Client, as a courtesy, of any new tickets of which Winit Law is made aware.

**Termination.**

Subject to applicable laws and regulations, each of Winit Law and Client has the right to terminate Winit Law's representation at any time for any reason upon written notice to the other party. Following termination by Winit Law, Winit Law will continue to provide representation in any matter for which it has been retained for a reasonable period of time, if requested by Client, until arrangements can be made for alternate representation in accordance with the Rules of Professional Responsibility governing the New York Bar. However, Winit Law's services will consist of only those necessary to protect Client's interests and prevent prejudice. Moreover, if substitute counsel has not been located and substituted within five (5) days of the termination of the representation, Client nonetheless agrees that appropriate papers allowing Winit Law to withdraw may be filed. All payments made by Client to Winit Law may be retained by Winit Law to cover the services rendered and other charges accrued on Client's behalf through the date of Winit Law's withdrawal or Client's termination, as applicable. If expressly requested by Client in writing (email being an acceptable form of writing), Winit Law will provide Client with reasonable and customary transition services to Client's substitute legal representative. If Client disputes any fee between \$1000 and \$50,000, Client may avail themselves of the arbitration procedures of the New York Dispute Resolution Program pursuant to 22 NYCRR Sect. 137.00; Winit Law will provide Client with the Rules for that Program upon request.

**Severability & Waiver.**

The Letter shall remain in effect in the event a section or provision is unenforceable or invalid. All remaining sections and provisions shall be deemed legally binding unless a court rules that any such provision or section is invalid or unenforceable, thus limiting the effect of another provision or section. In such case, the affected provision or section shall be enforced as so

limited. The failure of either party to enforce any provision of the Letter shall not be construed as a waiver or limitation of that party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of the Letter and/or hereunder.

**Force Majeure.**

Winit Law's incomplete performance or failure to perform its duties under these terms will not be considered a breach of these terms and shall be fully excused in the event of interruption and/or delay due to causes beyond our reasonable control, such as acts of God, acts of any government, war or other hostility, civil disorder, natural disasters (including without limitation, the elements, fire, and earthquake), explosion, acts of terrorism, power failures, equipment failure, industrial or labor disputes, acts of third party information providers, third party software errors or failures or communications interruptions or failures and all other events beyond Winit Law's reasonable control.

**Entire Letter.**

The Letter, together with any other attachments or addenda, represents the entire Letter between the parties. Therefore, the Letter supersedes any prior agreements, promises, conditions, or understandings between Client and Winit Law. The Letter may be modified or amended if the amendment is made in writing and is signed by both parties; provided, that, Winit Law reserves the right to amend, modify and update these Terms and Conditions from time to time in its sole discretion, and such changes will become binding on Client once they are sent to Client or are otherwise posted and made accessible by Winit Law on the Winit Law website.
